The programs that are currently taking applications are: Salvation Army and Eagle Ranch Ministries.

The following information is for the Salvation Army programs only:

Toys for Tots helps with toys only for children 15 and younger. Angel Tree can help with toys and clothing for children 12 and younger. Salvation Army will determine which program you will be eligible for.

Angel Tree and Toys for Tots will be taking applications on Dec. 10th, 11th, and 12th only from 10a.m. to 4p.m. They will be taking a lunch break between the hours of 12p.m. to 1p.m. The address is 679 South Main Street in SL at the Salvation Army building. It is a white building located on the NE corner of 700 South and Main Street. No appointment is necessary to apply. However they are only going to be taking applications for 3 days and then the program will end.

You will need to bring the following information with you. If you do not have all of the information with you at the time you apply you will not be able to complete your application and you will need to return at another time:

1. Photo ID for all adults, no exceptions.
2. Children's ID - original or certified birth certificates, baptismal papers, or school ID whatever you bring must show date of birth.
3. Income verification - You must bring verifiable proof of how you meet your current obligations, such as your last two current pay stubs or a letter from your employer stating your monthly income. If you are on State Assistance, you must obtain a current CAP II and financial printout from your caseworker. If you are receiving other assistance such as Medicaid, housing, help from your church or family member, etc you must bring proof of that. If you do not bring something that shows how you are living, they will be unable to help you.
4. Proof of current address – a bill or lease agreement.
5. You will not be served if children are with you. Please make arrangements with a friend or family member on the day you plan on applying for assistance. This can be a long process. Dress appropriately for weather conditions.

Parking is limited, however there are 2 Trax stops within walking distance. They are located on 490 South Main Street and 860 South 200 West.

The following information is for Eagle Ranch Ministries:

Eagle Ranch Ministries can help those who have been denied by Salvation Army or didn't apply for Salvation Army's programs. If Salvation Army denied you for assistance then you will need to take your rejection letter with you at the time you apply. They can also help children 16 and older for those who did apply with Salvation Army and were unable to get help for their older children. You will need to call 254-4945 and make an appointment to apply for assistance.

There is no guarantee that you will receive any assistance with any of these programs. It is based on a first come first serve basis. These are the only programs that we at 211 Information and Referral are aware of for extended assistance. If you are not able to
