

Dental Insurance Programs

CHIP

(Children's Health Insurance Program)

A program of the Utah Department of Health

Provides comprehensive health insurance, including limited dental, to Utah children who qualify.

Eligibility is determined by the Department of Workforce Services (DWS) or the Bureau of Eligibility Services (BES).

Fees: Quarterly premiums and co-payments for some services

Eligibility Requirements: U.S. citizen or legal resident, under age 19, at or below 200% of federal poverty income guidelines, and not covered by any other health insurance.

PCN (Primary Care Network)

A program of the Utah Department of Health

Provides health, and limited dental coverage for Utah adults who qualify. Dental services include: examinations, x-rays, cleanings, and fillings.

Fees: 10 % co-pay of allowed amount

Eligibility Requirements: Age 19 - 64, U.S. citizen or legal resident, fit within the PCN income guidelines (150% of federal poverty income guideline), and do not have access to student health insurance, Medicaid, Medicare, Veterans benefits, or health insurance. Individuals must apply during open enrollment.

Community Health Centers

Provide primary dental care for the low income and uninsured.

Fees: Co-pay or sliding scale—accepts Medicaid, PCN,CHIP, and some private insurances

Eligibility Requirements: Emergencies are accepted, however, depending on funding, new clients for ongoing treatment are not accepted.

Family Dental Plan

A program of the Utah Department of Health

Provides dental services (check-ups, cleanings, sealants, fillings, extractions, root canals, dentures and partials) to recipients of government assistance programs and those without dental insurance.

Fees: Co-pay if appropriate, reduced rate for those without insurance (cash only). Accepts Medicaid, PCN, CHIP.

Eligibility Requirements: Services are for clients who receive Medicaid, Primary Care Network (PCN), or CHIP dental benefits, and also those without dental insurance. No private insurance accepted.

Community Dental Clinics

Dental Hygiene Clinic

A program of Salt Lake Community College

Provides preventive dental services for adults and children. Does not provide restorative dental procedures such as fillings or root canals. (Majority of intakes are taken at the beginning of each school semester.)

Fees: Screenings are free, \$5 for treatment plan

Eligibility Requirements: Ages 5 years and older, must be available for possibly lengthy appointments.

Salt Lake Donated Dental Services Clinic

Provides dental work for those who qualify. Services include preventative, restorative, and limited denture treatment and oral surgery. Types of services contingent on dentist donating services. Walk in for all services except dentures, root canals, and/or oral surgery. Those may be scheduled after initial visit.

Fees: \$10 donation requested at time of service— accepts Medicaid and PCN

Eligibility Requirements: Clients must be at or below 100% of the federal poverty level and provide proof of income, i.e. must bring in paycheck stub to qualify or provide a shelter bed card or Medicaid, PCN, CHIP or Horizon card.

Community Dental Clinics

Primary Children's Medical Center Dentistry

A service of Intermountain Health Care (IHC)
Provides pediatric dental care to children with extensive or specialized dental needs.

Eligibility Requirements/Area Served: The clinics will not turn anyone away, but are intended to serve individuals and families at or below 150% of federal poverty guidelines, who do not have health insurance, and are not eligible for Medicare, Medicaid, homeless services, or other programs.
